**Rocky Mountain Law Journal Publication and Copyright Agreement  
Single Author**

The following is an agreement between \_\_\_\_\_, hereinafter referred to as the Author, and the *Rocky Mountain Law Journal*, hereinafter referred to as the Journal, and governs “ \_\_\_\_\_ ”, hereinafter referred to as the Article.

**1. Author’s Grant of Rights**

- 1.1. The Author grants to the Journal and its publisher a nonexclusive license throughout the world to publish, reproduce, distribute, and use the Article in all print or electronic formats and all languages, either separately or as part of a collective work, including but not limited to the nonexclusive right to publish the Article in an issue of the Journal, copy and distribute individual reprints of the Article, authorize reproduction of the Article in another publication by the Journal, and authorize the reproduction and distribution of the Article or an abstract thereof by means of computerized retrieval systems (such as Westlaw and Lexis).
- 1.2. The Author grants to the Journal the right to authorize another party (including reproduction rights organizations such as the Copyright Licensing Agency and the Copyright Clearance Center) to reproduce and distribute the Article in any form noted in Paragraph 1.1, provided that such reproduction identifies the Author, the Journal, the volume, the number of the first page, and the year of the Article's publication in the Journal.
- 1.3. In addition to the nonexclusive license and rights granted above, the Author grants to the Journal the exclusive right to print publication of the Article for a period beginning when this Agreement is executed and ending one (1) year after publication of the Article in the Journal. In no case may any subsequent print version of the Article, either substantially rewritten or otherwise, be published by another publisher within one (1) year of the actual publication date of the Article in the Journal without the express written consent of the Journal.
- 1.4. The Author grants to the Journal the power to assign, sublicense or otherwise transfer any and all rights granted under this Agreement, provided the Journal does not modify the Article without permission from the Author.
- 1.5. The Author agrees to affix a prominent notice to any copy, adaptation, or reproduction of this Article, citing the original publication of the Article in the Journal, in a format substantially similar to the following: “[Volume Number] ROCKY MOUNTAIN LAW JOURNAL [Starting Page Number of Article] ([Publication Year])”

**2. Author’s Ownership of Copyright and Reservation of Rights**

- 2.1. The Author retains ownership of the copyright in the Article, and all rights not expressly granted in this agreement. The Author expressly reserves the following rights:
  - 2.1.1. To reproduce and distribute copies of the Article, and to authorize others to reproduce and distribute copies of the Article, in any format, for educational purposes, subject to the limitations in Paragraph 1.3;
  - 2.1.2. To make electronic copies of the Article available on an Internet or Intranet site over which the Author has effective control, and through any collaborative research service such as the Social Science Research Network, provided that such copies bear a citation as noted in Paragraph 1.5; and
  - 2.1.3. To include the Article, in whole or part, in another work of which the Author is the sole or joint author or editor, provided that in either circumstance the Author may not submit a work for publication that is substantially the same as the Article to another periodical without the permission of the Journal sooner than one (1) year after publication of the Article, provided further that such work bears a citation as noted in Paragraph 1.5.

**6. Final Agreement**
